House Bill 957 would provide the lowest average annual increase in school funding since before the MAEP went into effect. During the Barbour administration, the average annual increase in funding per student was \$86.77. In the past six years, the current Legislature has increased funding per student, on average, by \$64.58 per year. HB 957 would provide an average annual increase per student of only \$32 for the next seven years, and it provides for no increase at all after full implementation in 2025.
